REPORT & CONSENT FOR DEMOLITION INFORMATION SHEET

WHEN IS A REPORT & CONSENT REQUIRED FOR ANY TYPE OF DEMOLITION OR CHANGING A FAÇADE

1. If more than half the volume of the building is to be demolished, including demolition works carried out within the previous 3 years.
2. If any part of the façade of the building is to be demolished.
3. If a building faces 2 streets the demolition of either façade will require a report & consent.
4. If a planning permit is required a report and consent is still also required.

FAÇADE MEANS - External wall including verandah, balcony, balustrading or any architectural feature forming part of the external wall, chimney or re-roofing that can be seen from the street.

STREET MEANS - Road, highway, carriageway, square and court (lanes, footways and driveways are not included).

INFORMATION TO BE SUBMITTED WITH A FORM A APPLICATION FOR REPORT & CONSENT

1. Completed Form A application form.
2. A copy of building plans. If partial demolition, highlight area to be demolished. Include any known previous demolition information
3. A fee of \$65.40.
