HOW TO APPLY

A one-page proposal should be submitted with a number of images (up to 10) to be used in your exhibition proposal (reproduced on a CD or clearly printed and labelled images). These should be submitted with a current Resume/CV (provide all contact details and the names and contact details of three referees) and a general application letter.

THINGS TO CONSIDER IN YOUR PROPOSAL

- Provide a full description of work, including media, content, key themes or ideas
- Do you/your group have a preferred exhibition month? (i.e. June 2018)
- Who is your target audience and how do you propose to promote your exhibition?
- Is there someone you'd like to launch your exhibition and are they aware of your work?
- Is your/your group's work complete or being developed?
- Is your/your group's proposal dependent on any funding?
- How do you intend to display your work (all 2D works must have a hanging mechanism)?
- How many items do you wish to include in your exhibition?
- What size do you anticipate most work will be?
- Is your exhibition proposal related to a theme associated with the Whitehorse Art Collection?
- Is your proposal linked to a citywide event or milestone?
- Do you have ideas for a public program, such as a Floortalk?

THE SELECTION PROCESS

The Subcommittee will consider all applications and successful artists/or groups will be notified by phone and/or mail at the earliest opportunity. The artwork, to be exhibited, must be original and created solely by the applicant/s. The Subcommittee may prohibit display of any artwork that it deems to be offensive or in contradiction of any of Council's policies. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified by mail.

APPLICATIONS ARE CONSIDERED BY A SUB-COMMITTEE EVERY 2 MONTHS.

Note: Gallery specifications can be provided on request.
