

FIXED PENALTIES FOR OFFENCES DEALT WITH BY INFRINGEMENT NOTICES

The fixed penalties that apply to the Community Local Law 2014 (Local Law) are:

- Designed as a deterrent;
- Considered to be appropriate
- In line with the State Government's penalty regime; and
- Scaled to reflect the impact of the offence on the community.

The fixed penalty amount for offences under the Local Law will be determined as part of the annual budget process.

Local Law Category one (1) means an offence under subclauses:

- 2.1 to 2.4 inclusive;
- 4.1 to 4.26 inclusive;
- 5.1 to 5.7 inclusive; and
- 7.1(f)

of the Local Law.

Local Law Category two (2) means an offence under subclauses:

- 3.3 to 3.7 inclusive;
- 4.27 inclusive; and
- 7.1(c), 7.1(d) and 7.1(g) inclusive

of the Local Law

Local Law Category three (3) means an offence under subclause number 7.1(e) of the Local Law
