Shared Cost Fencing Application Process

How much will Council contribute?

Council will contribute half of the cost of a 1.65 metre high timber paling fence

Can I construct a different style fence?

The private land owner will need to cover the additional cost of using an alternate fencing material or a fence higher than the standard paling fence height of 1.65 metres.

What is the process?

- Step 1 Contact Council to confirm your property is eligible for shared cost fencing.
- Step 2 Obtain quotes from 2 fencing contractors. For fencing jobs in excess of \$5,000 please obtain quotes from 3 fencing contractors.
- Step 3 Complete the application form and submit the 2 quotes to Council.
- Step 4 Council will contact you to confirm your application has been approved and issue a purchase order to the fencing contractor for Council's share of the cost.
- Step 5 Arrange the construction date with your fencing contractor and notify Council.
- Step 6 When the fence is complete you should pay only your share of the cost to the contractor. The fencing contractor will invoice Council for our share of the cost.
