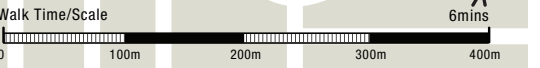

# Public Transport Information

Metlink is the one-stop-shop for all the information you need to know about Victoria's public transport services, fares and ticketing. Metlink makes train, tram, coach and bus travel easier with their website and journey planner, customer call centre, timetables, pocket guides, mobile phone applications and tools and wayfinding signage.

## Bikes and Public Transport

Bicycles can be carried free on metropolitan trains. You cannot board at the first door of the first carriage, as this is a priority area for mobility impaired passengers. Folding bikes, secured in a bag, can be carried free on trams and buses but must not exceed 82cm long x 69cm high x 39cm wide or have wheel rims of more than 51cm in diameter.

## Access & Mobility

### Trains

All stations are wheelchair accessible and have audio and visual passenger information systems. If you use a wheelchair, scooter or require assistance boarding, wait at the markers located on the station platforms, where the front of the train will stop and the train driver will assist with a ramp. Box Hill Station has wheelchair accessible parking and telephone facilities and is staffed from the first to the last train every day.

### Trams

Wheelchair accessible low-floor trams are progressively being introduced. There are many platform stops around the tram network that are accessible by wheelchair. Platform stops include passenger information display systems with audible and visual real-time information.

### Buses
