Retaining the heritage character of homes and buildings across Whitehorse is at the heart of the Heritage Assistance Fund.

Aim of Fund

Whitehorse City Council recognises the need to encourage and assist the maintenance and enhancement of heritage properties.

The **Heritage Assistance Fund** supports individuals, community groups and organisations to help maintain items of heritage significance in Whitehorse.

Funding Available

A total of \$40,000 is allocated to the Whitehorse Heritage Assistance Fund for the financial year. Funding up to a maximum of **\$2000** is available for eligible projects.

Please note that funding is not provided upfront. The grant is paid on the satisfactory completion of the works.

It is a condition of the fund that a property may only receive one grant per financial year, and the grant received may be less than the amount requested on the application.

Eligibility

All owners or occupiers of heritage properties listed in the Heritage Overlay (with the exception of non-contributory properties within a heritage precinct) are eligible to apply for funds. Publicly-owned properties are not eligible for funding.

Projects eligible for funding are those which seek to conserve or restore the fabric of heritage buildings, particularly those projects that are visible from the street and enhance the appearance of the building.
