Nunawading Community Hub Redevelopment October 2018

Construction set to start

The Nunawading Community Hub development on the former Nunawading Primary School site will start in coming weeks with Council recently awarding the building contract to Melbourne-based commercial construction firm Ireland Brown Constructions.

The Mayor said, "This is an exciting project for the residents of Nunawading and surrounds, and we are thrilled to partner with Ireland Brown Constructions in transforming the site into a vibrant community space where people of all ages and backgrounds feel welcome and can come together to embrace new opportunities for learning, social interaction and getting active".

To be the new home of community groups currently operating out of Silver Grove, Nunawading, the hub will feature a refurbished heritage school building, multi-functional classrooms, meeting rooms and function hall, specially-fitted out spaces for dance, art, counselling and lapidary activities, purpose-built Meals on Wheels facility and a full size single-court sports stadium.

The hub will also fully integrate with the adjacent Tunstall Park through extensive landscaping, new pedestrian and cycling paths, and dedicated areas for passive recreation.

Ireland Brown Constructions will establish its presence on site from early November 2018, and construction is expected to take place from late 2018 to early 2020. Throughout this period, they will keep local residents and other property owners informed of any changes to pedestrian or traffic movements, and mitigate against any potential construction impacts such as noise and dust, in accordance with their Construction Management Plan.

Council is pleased to see this community project enter the exciting construction phase and will continue to keep stakeholders and the broader community informed as it progresses.
