Kerbside services

Council provides weekly garbage and fortnightly recycling bin collections. The Food Organics and Garden Organics (FOGO) bin is an optional user-pays fortnightly collection.



Garbage Collected weekly 80L, 120L or 240L



Recycling **Collected fortnightly** 2401



FOGO (Optional) **Collected on alternate** fortnight to recycling 1401 or 2401

Council offers different bin sizes to suit vour needs:

- A standard service includes one 80 litre red-lid garbage bin and one 240 litre yellow-lid recycling bin.
- If you require extra or larger bins visit whitehorse.vic.gov.au/ order-bin or call Customer Service on 9262 6333. Additional charges apply.
- If you don't already have one, we encourage you to order a 140 or 240 litre FOGO bin.


Ensure your bins are collected by placing your bins out correctly.




Correct bin placement

- Place bins side by side leaving at least 50cm between bins and keep clear of obstructions (poles, trees, overhead wires etc.).
- Bins should be placed at least 1m clear from cars next to the kerb, with handles facing away from the road.

Place your bins correctly for your street type:




Dead endPlace all bins
on one side of

Court bowl

Do not place your bin in the court bowl end of your street.



Hammerhead
Do not place your
bin in the corners
of the hammerhead
of your street.

No overfilled bins

- Do not place rubbish on or next to your bin, these will not be collected.
- Do not overfill your bin, the lids must close.
- The maximum weight for all bins is 70kg.



Be on time

Place bins out the night before collection day. Once collected, return them back to your property within 24 hours.

Recycling tips:

- Empty contents of items before placing them in the bin

 no need to rinse.
- Squash bulky containers down to save space.

Liners must be coloured lime green and have the Australian Standard 4736 and seedling logo.

When you run out of liners, you can:

- Pick up a roll from customer service (limits apply).
- Use paper towel or newspaper to line your caddy.
- Place items loose in your caddy (rinse regularly).
- Purchase compostable lime green liners from from selected supermarkets, garden supply stores or online suppliers.

Human & animal hair

TIPS TO KEEP YOUR CADDY & BIN FRESH

- Keep meat, dairy and seafood scraps in the fridge or freezer until just before collection.
- Replace your liner every few days to avoid breakage.
- Don't overfill your caddy or your bin ensure the lid can close.
- Store your bin and caddy out of direct sunlight.
- Alternate garden waste and food waste layers in your bin.


FOGO materials are turned into compost for gardens and farms. It is important to ensure the correct materials go in the bin.

AVOID, REDUCE, REUSE & RECYCLE

- Buy items in bulk, with minimal packaging that is reusable or recyclable.
- **Donate or sell** used goods that are in good condition.
- Buy quality items that are going to last.
- Plan your meals to reduce food waste.
- Grow your own food, such as fruit, vegetables and herbs.
- **Invest in reusable items** e.g. bees wax wraps, drink bottle and coffee cup or reuse what you have, such as glass jars for storage.
- **Compost** your organic waste at home or use the food and garden organics service.

The garbage bin should be your last resort. Everything placed in the bin goes to landfill, where it is never used again.





Please bag all garbage to reduce pests and wind-blown litter.



Hard waste

Council provides two free hard waste collections each financial year. Additional bookings are available at a cost.

Book your collection

- Visit whitehorse.vic.gov.au/hard-waste
- Call our service provider on 9780 6120

Bookings close at 5pm on Wednesday for collection the following week. This may be longer in busy times.

- Bookings will be confirmed by email and/or SMS informing you of your collection week.
- Once your booking has been confirmed you will be mailed out an information pack with an orange 'BOOKED' sticker.
- Place the 'BOOKED' sticker on an item that is unlikely to be taken by someone else and can be clearly seen from the road.

Neatly present your collection

Place accepted items on the nature strip no earlier than the weekend before, and no later than 6am on the Monday of your collection week.

- Please ensure your booking is within the correct size limits.
- Where only a single booking is made, excess items will be counted as two collections.
- Items should be no heavier than 55kgs and no longer/wider than 2 metres (smaller limits apply for certain items).
- · Unaccepted items will not be collected.







Household appliances & whitegoods

Including washing machines, stoves & fridges (doors removed)



- Household furniture
- **Mattresses & bed bases** Maximum two items per collection





- 😭 **Timber** No longer than 1.5m and no more than 10 pieces
- 🗸 😭 Scrap metal & car parts Small items only

- **Branches & prunings** Up to 7.5cm in diameter and

no longer than 1.5m. Bundled and tied with string or twine and no wider than 30cm



Polystyrene

Solid polystyrene or plastic foam packaging (no beans, balls, etc.) securely bagged, boxed or tied and weighted down



Broken glass & crockery Glass items, ceramics and crockery

(wrapped and labelled 'glass' or 'crockery')

Electronic waste (E-waste)

E-waste is any unwanted item with a plug, battery or cord. E-waste must not go in your bins.

Large items can be recycled for free at our **Recycling and Waste Centre**.

Small items such as cords, computer devices and mobile phones, can be recycled for free at our Customer Service Centres or visit whitehorse.vic.gov.au/other-recyclingoptions for other drop off options.



Light globes

Light globes can be recycled

at our Recycling and Waste Centre and Customer Service Centres.

Fluorescent lights are accepted at our Recycling and Waste Centre.



X-Rays

Small quantities can be recycled at our Recycling and Waste Centre or Customer Service Centres.

Please provide as much information as possible, such as:

- Location
- Date and time
- Car registration
- Any other information about the person.
