Getting started is easy...

Your kit includes a roll of lime green compostable liners, a fridge magnet and a bin lid sticker to go on the top of your bin outside. 您的套件中包括一卷青柠绿色的堆肥垃圾袋、一个冰箱贴和一张贴在室外垃圾桶盖上的贴纸。



Step 1.

Line your kitchen caddy with the approved lime green compostable liner (AS 4736) 将经批准的青柠绿色堆肥垃圾袋 (AS 4736) 套入厨房堆肥箱

Open the liner and fit it inside your caddy. Secure the edges of the liner around the top of the open caddy.



Step 2.

Collect and store food waste in your caddy 收集食物垃圾并将其存放在厨房堆肥箱中

Keep the caddy somewhere shady and easy to access, like your kitchen bench or under the sink.





Step 3.

Empty your caddy into your lime green-lid bin 将厨房堆肥箱清空倒入青柠绿色盖子的垃圾桶

Food waste can go into your lime green-lid bin loose or tied up in the liner provided.

Empty caddy and replace liners regularly to avoid breakage, particularly in warmer months.

Step 4.

Put your lime green-lid bin out the night before collection

Your lime green-lid bin goes out fortnightly, on the alternate week to your recycling bin. Check your collection calendar or visit our website for your collection day.

Tips to keep your kitchen caddy and bin fresh

保持厨余堆肥箱和垃圾桶干净清新的方法



Layer your food and garden waste 将食物和花园垃圾分层



Don't overfill your caddy or bin, ensure the lid can close 不要把厨房堆肥箱或垃圾桶装得太 满,确保盖子可以关闭



Rinse your caddy regularly 定期清洗厨房堆肥箱



Sprinkle bi-carb soda to reduce smells 喷洒双碳苏打以减少气味



Keep your bin in the shade 将垃圾桶放在阴凉处



Wash your bin and caddy from time to time (kitchen caddies are dishwasher safe) 时常清洗垃圾桶和厨房堆肥 箱 (厨房堆肥箱可以使用洗 碗机洗)



Freeze smelly or rotten food in an airtight container and empty straight into the bin the night before collection 使用密闭容器存放发臭或腐 烂的食物,将其放入冰箱冷 藏,并在垃圾收集前一天晚 上直接倒入垃圾桶



Why recycle your food waste?

Approximately half of the average garbage bin in Whitehorse is food and garden waste.

Keeping food and garden waste out of landfill is one way we can reduce greenhouse gas emissions and help protect the environment.

What happens to your food and garden waste? ***

您的食物和花园垃圾会怎样处理?

It's important to get it right. The compost created from your organic waste is used to make plants and food grow in gardens and farms across Victoria.

Any items in the bin from the 'No' list can impact the compost quality making it hard for growers and farmers to use. Pet waste for example can contain pathogens which can't be used to grow food.

Reduce and reuse before recycling your food waste

Victorian household throw away \$2,200 worth of food on average a year. Save money and the environment by cutting food waste where you can.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQs)

How do I use my liners?

Gently tear a liner from the roll. Rub gently on the liner where it instructs you to do so to open the liner. Place the liner in the caddy and roll over the edges.

What if I already compost at home?

That's great! We encourage you to continue composting at home. This service does not replace home composting but it can complement it. Things like meat, seafood, dairy, citrus, garlic, onions and bread that can't go in your compost bin, but can all be recycled in your lime green-lid bin.

I haven't received my caddy and liners, where can I get them?

If you have a lime green-lid bin and haven't received caddies and liners, they can be picked up from a Customer Service Centre.

My lime green-lid bin is full with garden waste, how can I add food scraps?

Loose food scraps won't take up much space in your bin. If you need to make space, we recommend cutting your garden prunings or scraps into smaller pieces.

Where do I get extra compostable liners?



A roll of liners will be provided with the caddy. When you run out, you can do the following:

- Use paper towel or newspaper to line your caddy
- Purchase liners from the supermarket or online suppliers. They must be lime green in colour and include the AS 4736 certification and logo
- Pick up liners from one of our Customer Service Centres, subject to availability and limits per household.

I don't want this kitchen caddy and liners where can I return it?

Unwanted caddies and liners can be returned to one of our customer service centres.

Can I use the liners for my animal waste?

No, the compostable liners provided are meant for the food and garden organics service.

Can I start adding food in my lime green-lid bin straight away?

No, our service doesn't start until 1 July. Recycling food waste requires a different composting process.
