About Tip Vouchers

Council is committed to the responsible and sustainable management of rubbish and recycling in the City of Whitehorse.

The Tip Vouchers is a voucher based discount provided to eligible not-for-profit and incorporated organisations, clubs and groups to assist with the cost associated of waste disposal. They are determined through demonstrated need and within the available budget allocation.

Tip Vouchers are used to dispose of waste through Council's Recycling and Waste Centre.

Please note: Organisations that operate regionally across multiple government areas that have an annual surplus over \$250,000 from the previous financial year will not be eligible for the Tip Voucher program.

The provision of a Tip Voucher comes with the expectation that discount recipients will take an active recycling approach to ensure as little waste as possible enters landfill. The Whitehorse Recycling and Waste Centre accept some recyclable material free of charge, and as a result, collected items should be separated for this purpose. Key conditions

In addition to the Eligibility Criteria detailed above, the following applies to Tip Vouchers:

- Only one voucher can be used each trip.
- A maximum of one mattress may be disposed of per voucher.
- Council will not reimburse tipping costs already incurred.
- Vouchers must be presented to the Weigh Bridge Operator.
- Vouchers cannot be reproduced and if the vouchers are reproduced and or the allocation is exceeded, the organisation's participation in the community grants program will be reviewed.
- Replacement vouchers will not be issued.

Assessment

Applications that meet the criteria will be allocated Tip Vouchers based on:

- Demonstrated need
- Fair and equitable distribution of vouchers within the funding available for the relevant financial year.

Tip Voucher Options

General Waste (includes food waste, furniture and hard rubbish)

- Car Boot Load Voucher
- Station Wagon Car Load Voucher
- Ute/Van/ Trailer Truck up to 300kg Voucher
- Ute/Van/Trailer/Truck up to one tonne Voucher

Clean Green and Timber Waste (unpainted and untreated timber only)

- Ute/Van/Trailer/Truck up to 400kg Voucher
- Ute/Van/Trailer/Truck up to one tonne Voucher

Further information
