

'Construction Workers Parking Permit' Information 2017/2018



Local Government Act 1989, Section 113 and Schedule 11 Council may grant a permit for a prescribe a fee

Please allow a minimum of 10 working days for assessment of this application

Purpose

A 'Construction Workers Parking Permit' allows specific construction workers or tradesmen's vehicles to park their vehicles on-street within 50m of their construction site for a minimum of one (1) week up to a twelve (12) week period. Typically, 'Construction Workers Parking Permits' may be required for smaller projects where the parking opportunities may be limited due to the demand for parking and the existing on-street parking restrictions near the construction site.

Construction Parking Permit Notes

1. A maximum of four (4) Construction Workers Parking Permits may be issued to a construction site and each permit is specifically associated with a construction site.
2. Vehicles appropriately displaying a valid 'Construction Workers Parking Permit' are exempt to a permissive parking restriction (as defined under the Road Safety Road Rules 2009) providing that:
 - the parking control allows parking equal to or greater than half an hour parking; or
 - within a 'Permit Zone' parking restriction; and
 - is within 50m of the construction site.
3. Residential developments are not exempt to a parking restriction in front of a non-residential property
4. The permit fee varies depending upon the number of permits applied for, the type of on-street restriction that applies along the construction sites frontage.

Alternatives

For occupation of on-street parking spaces next a construction site, see Council's website on www.whitehorse.vic.gov.au/forms/engineering for the application form for temporary partial or full road closures for tasks such as unloading and loading of goods, crane lifts and concrete pours.

For projects that require parking for construction vehicles engaged in construction work in or near the site for at least a twelve (12) week period applying for a 'Works Zone' parking restriction for a fee should be considered. 'CONSTRUCTION WORKERS PARKING PERMIT' CONDITIONS

1. Vehicles associated with construction of a **residential development** appropriately displaying a valid 'Construction Workers Parking Permit' are exempt to a permissive parking restriction (as defined under the Road Safety Road Rules 2009) in front of residential properties **only** providing that:
 - the parking control allows parking equal to or greater than half an hour parking; or
 - within a 'Permit Zone' parking restriction; and
 - is within 50m of the construction site.
2. Vehicles associated with construction of a **non-residential development** appropriately displaying a valid 'Construction Workers Parking Permit' are exempt to a permissive parking restriction (as defined under the Road Safety Road Rules 2009) providing that:
 - the parking control allows parking equal to or greater than half an hour parking; or
 - within a 'Permit Zone' parking restriction; and
 - is within 50m of the construction site.
3. A 'Construction Parking Permit' is not valid in '2 minute' parking restriction, Disabled parking bays, Clearways, No Stopping areas, Bus Zones or within 10 metres of an intersection.
4. An administration fee as stated on page 2 of this application form is applicable to replace lost or damaged Construction Workers Parking Permit'.
5. Council reserves the right to cancel this 'Construction Workers Permit' at any time in consultation with the applicant if there has been a failure to comply with the conditions of this letter or the Council's Local Law and the Victorian Road Rules.

I have read and understand the above conditions relating to this application and am aware that as the applicant / permit holder, I am responsible for the use of the 'Construction Workers Parking Permits' in accordance with the above conditions.
