Proof of age, desexing and microchipping must be supplied.

Pensioners

If you currently hold an eligible pension card you are entitled to a reduced registration fee. Please present your card in person at time of registration. Please note that health care card holders are not entitled to registration discount.

Reduced Fees

To be eligible for the reduced fee for new registration you must provide evidence that your animal meets one of the following criteria: sterilisation, membership of approved association (animal and owner), obedience papers, breeding license or statutory declaration (see below).

Compulsory Desexing

As of 10 April 2020, cats being registered for the first time must also be desexed (unless exempt). Animals registered with Whitehorse City Council or any other council prior to this date are exempt from the compulsory desexing requirement.

Obedience Trained Animal

Discount is only available to the holder of a Dog Obedience Certificate as approved by the *Domestic Animals Act 1994.* For the purposes of the Schedule of the Act, obedience training that complies with these regulations is training of a dog other than a dangerous dog.

- 1. An assessment program administered by the Victorian Canine Association Inc. which results in the award of an obedience title.
- 2. An assessment program approved by the Minister and conducted by a qualified dog trainer who is a member of an organisation approved by the Minister.

Association Membership

Members of the following organisations: Australian National Cats Inc., Cats Victoria Inc., Dogs Victoria, Feline Control Council (Victoria) Inc., Greyhound Racing Victoria and the Governing Council of the Cat Fancy Australia and Victoria Inc.

Ownership

Pet owners must be over 18 years of age.

Microchipping

From 1 May 2007 Council cannot accept a new registration for a dog or cat unless it has been microchipped (proof must be provided). This also relates to animal registrations to be transferred to the City of Whitehorse.

Restricted Breeds

Restricted breeds as defined by the *Domestic Animals Act 1994* must be declared. These include Pitbull Terrier/American Pitbull Terrier, Fila Brasileiro, Dogo Argentino, Japanese Tosa and Perro de Presa Canario and their crosses.

Additional Pets

Council has a Local Law that allows residents to keep a maximum of three dogs or three cats and any combination of the two up to a total of four animals in certain circumstances. Pet owners wishing to keep more than the permitted number of pets must obtain a permit from Council.

State Government Levy

The registration fee includes a state government levy of \$4.10 for both cats and dogs and is primarily used to fund responsible pet ownership programs.
