Demolition Consent Certificate (29A - Report & Consent)

INFORMATION TO BE SUBMITTED

- 1. A copy of demolition plans.
 - Must contain a legend and clearly identify the footprint of the structure/s to be demolished.

In the case of a partial demolition, identify the area to be demolished. Include any known previous demolition information.

Do NOT include vegetation - vegetation removal will not be assessed in this process

- 2. Attach a current copy of title issued within the last 3 months.
- 3. A fee of \$96.60

WHEN IS A REPORT & CONSENT REQUIRED FOR ANY TYPE OF DEMOLITION OR CHANGING A FAÇADE

- 1. If more than half the volume of the building is to be demolished, including demolition works carried out within the previous 3 years.
- 2. If any part of the façade of the building is to be demolished.
- 3. If a building faces 2 streets the demolition of either façade will require a report & consent.
- 4. If a planning permit is required a report and consent is still also required.

FAÇADE MEANS - External wall including verandah, balcony, balustrading or any architectural feature forming part of the external wall, chimney or re-roofing that can be seen from the street.

STREET MEANS - Road, highway, carriageway, square and court (lanes, footways and driveways are not included).
