

# Get connected across Whitehorse

#### Introduction

This resource lists places in Whitehorse where there is publicly available WiFi or access to free WiFi within community organisations and community spaces.

It also points to organisations that provid a range of training and mentoring options, as well as where you can get refurbished low-cost digital devices.

#### Free or Public WiFi

Free public Wi-Fi is often available in shopping centres, libraries, cafes, and fast-food outlets. It is also sometimes available in art galleries, museums, city halls, sporting venues, gardens, universities, and hospitals. Look for signs that say Free Wi-Fi or Public Wi-Fi Hotspot.

## **Digital Skills Training & Mentoring**

Organisations such as libraries, neighbourhood houses and community centres offer supports to help improve digital skills. These include computer or digital skills training courses in groups or one to one as well as individual help with technology from a trained digital mentor. Training and support can be face to face or online. 'Be Connected' is a federally funded program available for free to people aged 55+. We have included information on who is running Be Connected as well as other training and mentoring options.

### **Accessing Computers and other Devices**

Alternatives to purchasing a new device include computers available in public buildings (such as libraries or community centres), programs to get devices on loan or refurbished low-cost devices for purchase.
