



Program details

Bin Bingo

Children will learn about waste sorting, recycling, and sustainability through interactive storytelling, movement-based games, and hands-on activities that explore the journey of rubbish and the role of each bin.

Climate Capers

Children will explore climate change, sustainability, and cultural respect through joyful storytelling, STEM play, and interactive activities that inspire care for the Earth.

Garden Munch

Children will explore bush foods and edible gardens through storytelling and hands-on activities, learning how First Nations peoples used native plants for food and medicine and how to grow their own snacks today.

Litter Legends

Children will learn how to identify, prevent, and clean up litter through engaging storytelling, active play, and hands-on clean-up games that inspire everyday environmental care.

Magnificent Minibeasts and Beauties

Children will discover the fascinating world of garden minibeasts through songs, stories, and hands-on encounters that explore their roles, features, and habitats.

Sun, Wind and Wiggles

Children will investigate renewable energy through playful experiments with solar toys, spinning wheels, and movement-powered creations.

Children will explore reuse, recycling, and nature's waste-free cycle through joyful storytelling, hands-on crafts, and playful ecothemed activities.

Children learn the fundamentals of worm farming and composting through an engaging incursion featuring music, movement, puppetry, and hands-on interaction with live worms.
