Terms and Conditions

1. You can only submit one entry in your age group to the competition.
2. Only children who live in Whitehorse may enter.
3. A parent or guardian must sign each entry accepting the Terms and Conditions.
4. Prizes will be awarded by age group, to an entry that meets all the criteria. The judges' decision is final and there will be no correspondence entered into.
5. There is one prize for each age group (3-6 year olds, 7-10 year olds and 11-13 year olds). The total value of the overall prizes is up to \$164.85, inclusive of GST.
6. This competition is organised by Whitehorse City Council (Council), ABN 39 549 568 822
7. Competition starts on the 2 November 2020 and ends on 15 November 2020 at 11 pm. All entries must be received before 11 pm on 15 November 2020.
8. Entrants may scan or take an image of their entry and email it to wasteteam@whitehorse.vic.gov.au
9. The winners will be decided by Council's Sustainability Team. Judging will be completed by the 20 November 2020.
10. Winners will be notified by email by 25 November 2020.
11. Parents of winners will be asked to take a photo of their child holding their artwork to be used in Council's communications channels. Only names, age, suburb and the image will be published and no other personal details will be published.
12. By submitting your entry you acknowledge and agree that Council may publish and promote winners (name, suburbs and images submitted): on Council's website, on social media, Susty e-newsletter and other communications.
13. Personal details relating to entrants will be used solely in accordance with current Australian privacy and personal information protection legislation and will not be used for other purposes.
14. Prizes will be sent out to the winners at the mailing address that is provided with their entry.
15. Personal details of entrants will be kept by Council for up to three years for auditing purposes and will not be used for any other purposes except for what is stated above.

Tips on submitting your entry

Capturing your document via smart phone

- Shoot in portrait mode and allow a small border around all four edges of the document.
- Post the document up on a wall using blue tack or place it on a flat surface (eg. table) and simply stand over it to capture the image.
- Use sufficient, natural lighting instead of flash. Find a well-light environment that is protected by direct sunlight to avoid shadows/reflection.
- Focus on the document by tapping the centre of your phone screen before taking the shot.
